3. Competition details and regulations:

All matches shall be conducted in accordance with FIK's "The Regulations of Kendo Shiai and Shinpan (26th July, 2023)" and "Provisional Match and Referee Rules as developed by All Japan Kendo Federation (1st April, 2023)" (Any amendments made to the regulations hereafter shall be included)

(A1) Children Individual Event (Age 6-9, unisex)

- No Kyu, Dan and Nationality restriction
- All matches under this category will be at 2 minutes duration and each match will be played by 3 Bon-Shobu.
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and kiai. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- For final match, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and Kiai (気合). The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.

(A2) Children Individual Event (Age 10-12, unisex)

- No Kyu, Dan and Nationality restriction
- All matches under this category will be at 2 minutes duration and each match will be played by 3 Bon-Shobu.
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and kiai. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- For final match, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and Kiai (気合). The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.

(B1) Male Teenage Individual Event (Age 13-17 Male)

- No Kyu, Dan and Nationality restriction
- All matches under this category will be at 2 minutes duration and each match will be played by 3 Bon-Shobu.
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and kiai. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- For final match, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and Kiai (気合). The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.

(B2) Female Teenage Individual Event (Age 13-17 Female)

- No Kyu, Dan and Nationality restriction
- All matches under this category will be at 2 minutes duration and each match will be played by 3 Bon-Shobu.
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and kiai. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- For final match, if a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the athlete's spirit and Kiai (気合). The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.

(C1) Women's Individual Event (Age 18-70, No Dan to 2 Dan)

- All athletes in this event must be No Dan to 2 Dan; aged 18 to 70; female.
- Knock-out format.
- The duration of all matches in this category will be 3 minutes and each match will be played by "San-Bon-Shobu".
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the athlete's posture, techniques, and any fouls (Hansoku) committed. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- For final match, if a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed. The athlete first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.
- CKOU participants **CANNOT** claim CKOU points with this result.
- An athlete **who is 3 Dan or above CANNOT** enrol in both this and the (C2) event.

(C2) Women's Individual Event (Age 18-70, No restrictions on Dan)

- All athletes in this event must be aged 18 to 70; female; no nationality restriction; no restrictions on Dan.
- Knock-out format.
- The duration of all matches in this category will be 3 minutes and each match will be played by "San-Bon-Shobu".
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the

athlete's posture, techniques, and any fouls (Hansoku) committed. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.

- For final match, if a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed. The athlete first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.
- CKOU participants **CAN** claim CKOU points with this result.
- Any athlete **cannot** enrol in **both** this and the **(C1)** event.

(D1) Men's Individual Event (Age 18-70, No Dan to 2 Dan)

- All athletes in this event must be No Dan to 2 Dan; aged 18 to 70; male; no nationality restriction.
- Knock-out format.
- The duration of all matches in this category will be 3 minutes and each match will be played by "San-Bon-Shobu".
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the athlete's posture, techniques, and any fouls (Hansoku) committed. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- For final match, if a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed. The athlete first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.
- CKOU participants **CANNOT** claim CKOU points with this result.
- An athlete **who is 3 Dan or above cannot** enrol in this event.

(D2) Men's Individual Event (Age 18-70, No restrictions on Dan)

- All athletes in this event must be aged 18 to 70; male; no nationality restriction; no restrictions on Dan.
- Knock-out format.
- The duration of all matches in this category will be 3 minutes and each match will be played by "San-Bon-Shobu".
- For preliminaries to the semi-finals matches, If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the athlete's posture, techniques, and any fouls (Hansoku) committed. The athlete with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- For final match, if a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed. The athlete first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the

Encho.

- CKOU participants **CAN** claim CKOU points with this result.
- Any athlete **cannot** enrol in both this and the **(D1)** event.

(E) Women's 3-members Team Event (Age 18-70, No restrictions on Dan)

- ALL athletes/substitutes in this event must be female and aged 18 to 70 and no restrictions on Dan; the organizer reserves the right to disqualify any athletes under the age of 18.
- Each team will consist of 3 athletes (not require to have the same nationality, and can have one additional athlete as a reserve athlete)
- Any country or area with only 2 athletes in a team, the competition sequence will be Senpo and Taisho.
- Any team with less than 3 athletes, the team may request the organizer to invite local members or members from other countries to join the team.
- An athlete cannot participate in more than one team in this event (no matter as a athlete or substitute; same or different countries).
- The pre-registered substitute can only replace the injured athlete in the same team; and the sequence of the team cannot be changed when the replacement is made (e.g. If Taisho withdraws due to injury, the substitute can only replace the Taisho position);
- The duration of all matches in this category will be 3 minutes and each match will be played by San-Bon-Shobu.
- In case of two teams tie with same scores or winner cannot be determined, each team has to send a representative for a playoff with no time limit by Ippon-Shobu, the athlete who first scores one point will be the winner.
- Team order (Senpo, Chuken, Taisho) CANNOT BE CHANGED once submitted to the organizer in the preliminary heats.
- For all matches after the preliminary heats, team order can be changed (Reshuffling will be restricted to 4 registered athletes in the team given as maximum in the entry form). Each team MUST submit its team order list (if any update) to the presiding referee (Shinpan-shunin) for approval in each match before it starts.
- If the presiding referee (Shinpan-shunin) does not receive any new team order list, your team order is presumed to remain the same as the previous match.
- Each team is required to double check the order on the scoreboard and please inform the presiding referee (Shinpan-shunin) immediately for any mistake found.

(F) Men's 5-members Team Event (Age 18-70, No restrictions on Dan)

- ALL registered athletes/substitutes in this event must be at the aged 18 to 70, male and no restrictions on Dan. The organizer reserves the right to disqualify any athletes/substitutes under the age of 18.
- Each team consists of five athletes (not require to have the same nationality, and can have one additional athlete as a reserve athlete).
- Any country or area team with only 3 athletes to compete in the 5-member team

- events, the competition sequence will be Senpo, Chuken and Taisho (1, 3 & 5).
- Any country or area team with only 4 athletes to compete in the 5-member team events, the competition sequence will be Senpo, Chuken, Fukusho and Taisho (1, 3, 4 & 5).
 - Any team with less than 5 athletes, the team may request the organizer to invite local members or members from other countries to join the team.
 - A athlete cannot participate in more than one team in this event (no matter as a athlete or substitute; same or different countries).
 - A replacement (substitute) can only be made if any athlete from the same team withdraws from injury; the substitute must be registered under the same team beforehand and order of the team cannot be changed at the time a replacement is made (e.g. Taisho of the team has sustained injury, the substitute can replace the Taisho position only).
 - All matches will have 3 minutes duration and each match will be played by San-Bon-Shobu.
 - If two teams tie with same scores or winner cannot be determined, each team has to send a representative for a playoff with no time limit by Ippon-Shobu, the athlete who first scores one point will be the winner.
 - Team order (Senpo, Jiho, Chuken, Fukusho, Taisho) submitted to the organizer CANNOT BE CHANGED in the preliminary heats.
 - For all matches after the preliminary heats, team order can be changed (Reshuffling will be restricted to a maximum of 7 registered athletes in the team given in the entry form). Each team MUST submit its team order list (if any update) in each match to the presiding referee (Shinpan-shunin) for approval before the matches start.
 - If the presiding referee (Shinpan-shunin) does not receive any new team order list, your team order is presumed to remain the same as the previous match. Each team MUST submit its team order list (in any update) to the presiding referee (Shinpan-shunin) in each match before it starts.
 - Each team is required to double check the order on the scoreboard and please inform the presiding referee (Shinpan-shunin) immediately for any mistake found.

4. Shinai check

All shinais will have to be checked on the day and stamped with different colors for identification of men and women events.

5. Trophies and medals

Trophies or medals will be awarded to the winners, second place and two third place in all events. Shinpan-shunin of each court will nominate athletes for the Fighting Spirit Awards.

6. Enrolment Procedure

Participating regions are required to fill in the application form and submit to HKKA by fax or email, which should include the following details:

- i) Full name of the regional team and the Dojo in both Chinese and English
- ii) The number of teams and the names of athletes in both Chinese and English
- iii) Age, gender and nationality and Dan
- iv) Disclaimer of Consent Form
- v) Individual contestants and accompanying staff are only allowed to represent a single area or group
- vi) Overseas holders of FIK approved Kendo 6 Dan or above qualifications and CKOU members with FIK approved Kendo 5 Dan or above qualifications familiar with the FIK trial regulations are welcome to be the referee. Interested parties please fill in the registration form with your own personal information.
- vii) Accommodation will be waived for invited referees with 6 Dan or above (overseas) and referees with 5 Dan or above (CKOU).
